Dear Sponsor,

Thank you for your time and effort in the sponsorship of our university students!

The AWC is dedicated to helping committed Nigerian women and men from Lagos, who are currently attending undergraduate university full-time, to complete their education. To determine a student's eligibility for this program, the following documents and information **must be** submitted by him or her to you, and then to us:

1. A completed application form. An address in Lagos is mandatory.
2. Verification of enrollment (form is attached to student's packet).
3. A copy of the student's transcript from secondary school.
4. A copy of JAMB results.
5. A current copy of student's school ID
6. A copy of grades/assessments from university.
7. A letter of recommendation from the American Women's Club sponsor [sponsor's responsibility].
8. Two recent signed and dated passport photographs of the student.
9. Receipts for all expenses for tuition, books and student fees.

The deadline for the student to submit the above paperwork to you is *before* January 31, 2013. **All completed applications should be given directly to you, the sponsor, in ample time for you to review it and give it to the Scholarship Committee by January 31, 2013.** Any application received after this date **will not** be considered.

Please be sure your applicant knows that there is a mandatory interview for all new applicants on **Saturday, March 23, 2013 beginning at 9 a.m.** Interviews will be held at the US Guest Quarter (GQ). At the interview, the student should be prepared to write a one-page essay on a topic that will be presented at that time. ***He or she MUST appear in person at this interview to be considered for a scholarship.***
